LESSONS

Drum & Guitar Studio offers private lessons in drum, guitar, and bass for LCA students in grades 1 - 12.

Each lesson is 30 minutes and can be scheduled before school, after school, or during the school day if the student schedule allows.

Students can expect to receive a minimum of 14 lessons per semester.

Lesson Arrival

Lower School Students: For lessons during the school day, Mr. Lee will pick up Lower School students at their classroom and return them to their classroom when the lesson is over.

Middle and High School Students: Upper school students are expected to go to their lesson at the assigned time. If a student arrives late, the lesson time will not be extended. If a student does not appear, the family will be notified via email. This lesson will not be credited or made up.

Lesson books and/or music must be brought to school on the lesson day. If not, the instructor has the option to cancel the lesson. This lesson will not be credited or made up.

Make-Up Lessons

Our goal is to provide make up lesson times for all missed lessons however, this is not always feasible.

Lessons are not guaranteed to be made up expect in the following circumstances:

- Instructor absence if a substitute can't be arranged.
- School-sponsored field trips, events, or assemblies. Please note: For students enrolled in LCA sports, a 24-hour notice is required if a student is unable to attend his lesson due to a scheduled sport activity. If the instructor is not notified, the lesson will not be made up.

TUITION & FEES

1) A one-time, non-refundable registration fee of \$50.00 is due at the time of enrollment.

2) Lessons can be signed up by semester or for the entire school year.
--**Semester Lessons:** \$600 / semester or \$120 per month. 1st semester is August - December, 2nd semester is January - May.
--**Year Long Lessons:** \$1150 or \$115 / month.

3) Tuition may be paid in monthly payments due on the 5th of each month or paid in full. A 5% tuition discount is available if paid in full by Monday, August 14 (1st semester/year long lessons) or Monday, January 8 (2nd semester lessons).

4) Monthly installment payments are the same each month for 10 months., August - May. There are no partial month discounts.

5) A late fee of \$15.00, per student, is charged if tuition is not received by the 5th of each month.

WITHDRAWAL

1) Budgets are set based on enrollment. Therefore, families will be required to commit to lessons for a full semester or year.

2) In the event of early withdrawal, the parent or guardian must notify the teacher, in writing, noting the date and reason for withdrawal.

3) In the event that withdrawal becomes inevitable, a withdrawal fee of \$200 will be assessed.

4) The withdrawal fee must be paid at the time of withdrawal.
